

2 YEAR LL.M IN BUSINESS & TRADE LAW

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- An applicant who has graduated in law from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the statute of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for LL.M degree course.
- Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% of total marks in case of general category applicants 40% of total marks in case of SC & ST applications.
- The applicant who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination from recognized University / Boards of examination that are situated outside Karnataka or in a Foreign Country shall compulsorily obtain the **ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE** before taking the admission. The fee for Eligibility certificate is Rs. 2200/- for Indian students & Rs. 11,000/- for foreign students.
- The candidate is required to submit all the marks cards along with transcripts issued by the concerned University or Board or department.
- The qualifying degree certificates should be in Kannada or in English only.

Application forms can obtained from the office of the Principal, Ramaiah College of Law, Bengaluru on payment of Rs. 1100/- in Person OR by post. DD drawn in favor of "M.S.Ramaiah College of Law, payable at Bengaluru.
