Moot Court Competitions

Legal Aid and Awareness Camps

With this objective, faculty and students visit many schools, colleges and slums in and around Bengaluru to conduct awareness programmes on highlighting the importance of law, various social problems and their solutions through legal means.

GUEST LECTURES



RCL believes in the principle of Swami Vivekananda, “The goal of mankind is Knowledge.” Keeping this goal in mind RCL engages luminaries from both legal and non-legal field to broaden the understanding of students from time to time. In pursuit of this, “Justice V.R. Krishna Iyer Commemorative Lecture Series” was inaugurated on 22nd April, 2016 by Padma Shree. Prof. (Dr.) N. R. Madhava Menon, Hony. Professor, IBA Chair on Continuing Legal Education, NLSIU, Bengaluru. Prof. (Dr.) V. Vijayakumar, Professor of Law, NLSIU, Bengaluru was the Guest of Honor. Prof. (Dr.) N. R. Madhava Menon spoke about Justice V. R. Krishna Iyer’s achievements and his contribution to the legal field. Prof. (Dr.) Sarasu E. Thomas, Professor of NLSIU and Head of the Center for Women and the Law, NLSIU which works with the Government of India and other organizations for womens’ rights delivered a lecture on “Intricacies of Gender Justice Measures”. Mr. Na. Vijayashankar (popularly known as Naavi) a Cyber Law Educationist and E- Business Consultant delivered a guest lecture on “New Horizons of Cyber Crimes and the Indian Legal Framework” on 3rd November, 2015. A lecture was delivered by Hon’ble Mr. Justice Gururajan, on “Constitution with reference to Article 21” on 22nd February 2016.

The College also conducts seminars/group discussions relating to cases on emerging areas of law. To further improve the communication and presentation skills of students, the College requires all students to give seminars on different topics in every subject as a part of their academic curriculum.

COLLABORATIONS AND MOUs

- RCL has an MOU with NLSIU Bengaluru to collaborate with the law school in organizing seminars, conferences, workshops, training programmes, short bridge courses and faculty development programmes throughout the year. Faculty members of the College are also permitted under this MOU to attend the IBA-CLE workshops for teachers initiated by NLSIU periodically throughout the year.
- RCL has signed an MOU in August 2016 with Surana and Surana International Attorneys, Chennai to jointly organize a national legal essay writing competition every year and to hold a national tort law moot court competition every alternate year.
- RCL has collaborated with Trans-India Law Associates in February 2016, a law firm based in New Delhi in order to send students for internships and placements on a long term basis and also to allow students to attend seminars, conferences and workshops organized by the law firm. Students will also be permitted to participate in research projects initiated by the firm.
- RCL also has an MOU with Aavid Education Foundation, Bengaluru in February 2016 to provide coaching for the foundation level exam for the post of Company Secretary and to orient and train students about the nitty-gritties of company secretarial practice.
- RCL has collaborated with the Karnataka State Legal Services Authority to organize legal aid and awareness camps both within and outside the college premises. The target areas will be Bengaluru and its surrounding districts. This step was taken to organize and consolidate the earlier continuous efforts of conducting such programmes. Through this collaboration, volunteers of the legal aid cell also have an opportunity to participate in two research projects initiated by the state authority, on drug abuse and human trafficking.

RECRUITMENT POLICY AND PROCEDURE

- The recruitment process of RCL is handled by its Corporate Affairs and Outreach Cell consisting of two faculty coordinators and a variable number of student coordinators from the final year of the 5 years integrated BALLB degree course.
- The placement process commences initially with the process of contacting organizations from the month of June-July in each year.
- Simultaneously, the registration process for the interested candidates is held during July-August of every consecutive year.
- Organizations generally begin arriving at the campus for recruitments from September of every year.
- Students from the fourth year and fifth year are given periodic orientation about placements and are required to undergo a rigorous training and grooming regime both individually and in groups.
- The College provides internships and placement assessment internships to fourth and fifth year students as per the discretion of the recruiters and availability of slots. This is due to the fact that RCL realizes that the internship network leads to the placement network and good placements is all about establishment of long term relations with recruiters.
- RCL follows a single offer rule and a student who gets the first final offer is considered to be segregated from the placement process. Students who get offers are no longer allowed to sit for the recruitment process of any other subsequent organizations.
- In case students get recruited by organizations within Bengaluru, RCL allows the recruitees to join their respective offices in the ninth and tenth semester on a part-time basis after class hours subject to confirmation and approval from the recruiter.
