

### **Admission Policy – 2018-19**

The admission to Ramaiah College of Law has always been transparent, methodical and merit based which has enabled us in achieving excellence in legal education.

- All enquiries regarding admission to different courses offered by Ramaiah College of Law will be documented through duly filled “**Enquiry Forms**”.
- There are two steps for any candidate who applies for the Five Year Integrated B.A. LL.B / B.Com. LL.B / BBA. LL.B Course namely the filling up of the “**Application Form for Registration**” & “**Application Form for Admission**”.
- The revised Admission Policy, 2018 of the college which gives preference to CLAT score along with the new courses offered will be reflected on the college website from **06<sup>th</sup> January, 2018**.
- The registration to various programmes offered by Ramaiah College of Law has commenced from **1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018** through advertisements in online portals and college website. Candidates can obtain the “Application Form for Registration” from the College Website as well as in the College Administrative Section.
- The admission to the various programmes offered by RCL will be called through the advertisements in leading national dailies, online portals and college website after the admission notification issued by KSLU.

- The admission process shall be as follows:
  - An Admission Process Review Committee (APRC) comprising of the Principal, three senior faculty members and an administrative office in-charge shall supervise and approve the admission through a selection process.
  - The candidate belonging to the General Category with minimum 60% marks and above (in case of SC/ST 40%) at the 10+2 level, will be eligible for the selection process provided in Annexure 1.
  - The candidates with CLAT scores shall be given preference. Candidate having eligibility of 50% of CLAT score (100/200) will appear for the personal interview before the APRC and will be given admission after satisfying the selection criteria as provided in Annexure 1.
  - In case of non-CLAT candidates and students obtaining less than 50% in CLAT score are required to take a RCL Entrance Test in CLAT format and a personal interview with the Admission Process Review Committee. Test and personal interview will be held in batches or individually as and when students approach. The APRC will decide and approve the admission immediately on qualifying the selection criteria as provided in Annexure 1.
  - After the completion of the admission process, the merit list shall be prepared accordingly along with the students in the waiting list. (CLAT & Non-CLAT).
  - The final list of students enrolled for the course along with the category wise and gender wise distribution shall be prepared for the approval of the committee.

- After securing admissions, students who wish to withdraw their candidature shall be given reimbursement in the following manner:
  - A Processing fee of Rs.5000 for the withdrawal before 16/06/2018 will be deducted and balance may be refunded.
  - Between 18/06/2018 to 23/06/2018 – 90% of the total amount will be refunded.
  - Between 25/06/2018 to 30/06/2018 – 80% of the total amount will be refunded.
  - Between 02/07/2018 to 07/07/2018 – 70% of the total amount will be refunded.
  - Between 09/07/2018 to 14/07/2018 – 60% of the total amount will be refunded.
  - Between 16/07/2018 to 25/07/2018 – 50% of the total amount will be refunded.
  - After -26/07/2017 – No refund is permitted.
  - Students who opt to discontinue the course midway are under the obligation to pay the full course fee subject to the policies of the college.
- Decision of the APRC shall be final.
