

**3rd SURANA & SURANA AND DR. M.S. RAMAIAH COLLEGE OF LAW  
NATIONAL TORT LAW MOOT COURT COMPETITION & JUDGMENT WRITING  
COMPETITION, 2020**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Surana & Surana and Dr M.S. Ramaiah College of Law National Tort Law Moot Court Competition and the Judgment Writing Competition, 2020, organised by Ramaiah College of Law, Bengaluru in collaboration with the Surana & Surana International Attorneys was held virtually during 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of August, 2020.

Despite the challenging circumstances created by the public health emergency that we witnessed across the globe, the competition received an overwhelming response with the participation of a total of 48 teams from all over India.

On the first day of the Competition, a researcher's test was conducted virtually and on the basis of researcher's test scores and memorial scores, the top 16 teams were promoted to the Octa-Final Rounds. The Octa Finals and the Quarter Final Rounds were conducted on the second day. The four highest scoring teams from these rounds got promoted to the Semi-Finals. The Semi-Finals and the Finals were conducted on the third and the final day followed by a Valedictory Session on the same day.

After the Octa Finals and the Semi Final rounds, the University Law College, Bangalore and the Tamil Nadu National Law University came out as exceptional performers securing their positions as competitors in the Final Round of the Competition. In the Final Round that witnessed awe-inspiring, formidable and lively performances from the participating teams, the University Law College, Bangalore emerged as the winners of the Competition while the Tamil Nadu National Law University finished the race with the 2<sup>nd</sup> position. The Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur was judged as the team holding the 3<sup>rd</sup> position in the Competition.

In the Judgment Writing competition which was held as a part of the Competition, the participants were required to write and submit the judgements on the same moot problem. In the Judgment Writing Competition, the Pravin Gandhi College of Law, Mumbai emerged as the winners.
